Selection of Works for Exhibition:

NO pre-selection will take place.
MAANZ makes no guarantee that all works entered will be exhibited & reserves the right to reject any entry.
All entries must be delivered to the stated address by the date and times indicated.
Late entries may not be considered.
No reasons will be given & no correspondence will be entered into about these decisions.

Format:

Each artist can enter 1 work.

Theme is 'Nature- Finding Inspiration In the Natural World'

2D Work to be no larger than 40cmX40cm, maximum depth of 8cm (including substrate) and max weight of 10 kg.

Up to 5 sculptures can be accommodated.

Please confirm with exhibition coordinator prior to completing entry form to confirm if space is available for your sculpture work. Size limits may apply.

Work prepared for hanging with two d-rings & wire.
Felt protectors on the back.

Artist Statement/s:

Each work must be accompanied by an **artist statement** of **100 words or less**. Keep your statement simple & use your own words.

Digital images:

Each image saved as **JPEGS** at the best resolution of your camera with a file size not greater than 2MB or saved at 300dpi. Images to be taken face on (for Wall Hanging work), in focus, no background or very plain background so as not to distract, no date stamp and no heavy photo editing

Images Marked As: All images to be marked as follows: surname_firstname_title_size. See below for examples:

Each work must be marked clearly on the back with the artist's name, title of work, medium/s used, size & price.

The Lowdown on the MAANZ Victoria 2018 Exhibition

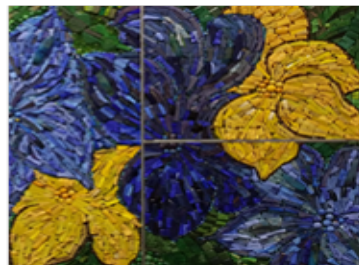
The theme this year is Nature: Finding Inspiration in the Natural World.

This broad theme allows you to be inspired by nature and its many patterns, colours, images, moods and materials. Think oceans, forests, birds, trees, animals, coral reefs, fish, sunrise, leaves, flowers, icebergs, clouds, butterflies, mountains, sunsets, frogs, starry nights and so much more. Zoom in (cells and microscopic images) or pull back (vistas and land or seascapes). Use natural materials such as minerals, crystals, bones, gum nuts, pebbles, sand, shells, marble or wood slices. Work literally or abstract. The choice is all yours.

This year we are asking exhibition visitors to vote for their favourite works. The People's Choice Awards will be announced at the closing event.

Due to gallery space, entries are limited to one per person; size is restricted to max 40cmx40cm for 2D works. We can accommodate up to 5 sculptures so please communicate with the exhibition coordinator before entering a sculpture to ensure we have room for you. It will be a first come first served basis. Size limits may apply.

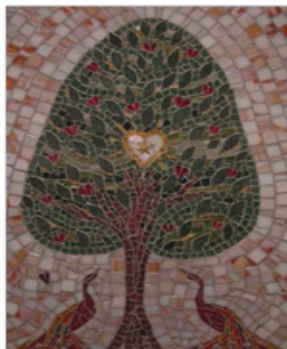
